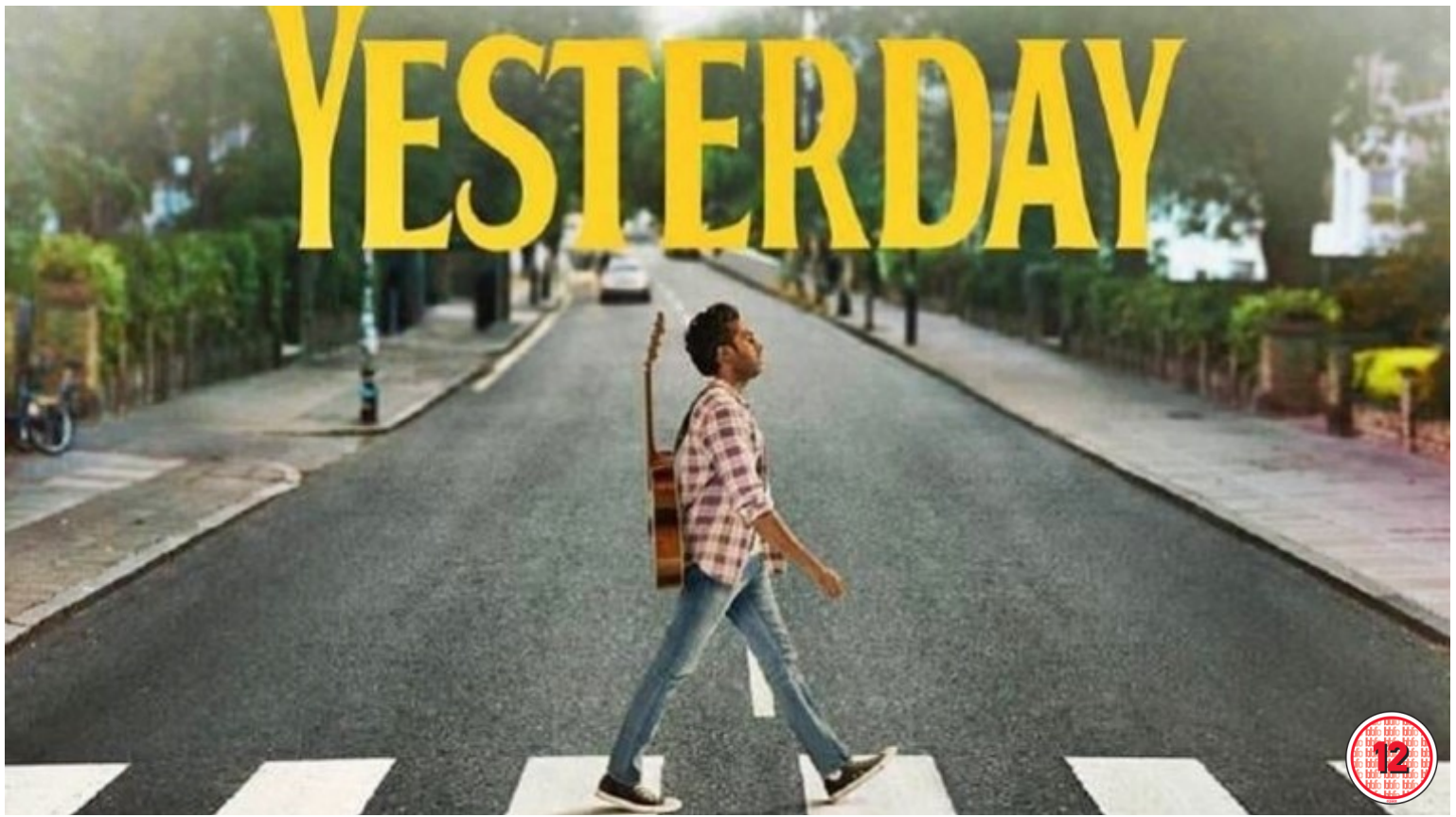


YESTERDAY
